

GE Brings Good Things to Life— and to Day Spring

Many donors to nonprofit organizations like Day Spring are not aware that they can double their gift to their favorite charity by applying for a matching gift donation from their employer. Hundreds of companies have a matching gift program that eligible employees can tap into to increase the size of each charitable donation they make by up to 100 percent.

For example, let's say you are a current or retired employee of a company that has a matching gift program. If you make a donation of \$100 to Day Spring, you can apply for a matching gift through your benefits administrator or through the company's website. Often, these companies match eligible donations dollar-for-dollar. That means Day Spring would receive a total of \$200—\$100 from you and an additional \$100 from your employer! When many donors participate in a matching gift program, the dollars add up.

In fact, since 1999, Day Spring donors who are current or retired employees of a number of matching gift companies in the Louisville area (including GE, BellSouth, and Monsanto), have applied for—and were granted—more than \$20,000 in matching monies for Day Spring. GE alone has granted \$11,449 in matching gifts to Day Spring, thanks to our donors who have taken the time to apply for this money.

How can you help Day Spring by participating in a matching gift program?

First, check this list of matching gift companies to see if your current or former employer is listed. If not, talk to your benefits administrator and inquire about the company's matching gifts status and eligibility rules. If your employer does offer a matching gift program, ask them if Day Spring is an eligible recipient of matching gift monies. If not, ask what is required to become an eligible charity. (The development office can provide any documentation your company may require.) Ask your company how to apply for matching gift funds. It's usually a quick and easy process. Do this every time you make a donation to Day Spring to maximize your contribution.
