

# THE SUPPORT FOR COMMUNITY LIVING WAIVER

The SCL Waiver is a *requirement* for all Day Spring residents.

Support for Community Living (SCL) Waiver: As part of Kentucky's Medicaid waiver program, SCL provides assistance to individuals with an intellectual or developmental disability to help them live in the community as independently as possible.

### Services:

- Vehicle Adaptation
- Personal Assistance
- Positive Behavior Supports
- Residential Support Services

## How to Apply:

Applicants will be served based on category of need (family planning, urgent, or emergency) and order of application as slots become available. There is a waitlist.

Once you are ready to apply for SCL Waiver services, you can complete your application online [https://kynect.ky.gov/benefits], or in-person at an <u>Aging and Disability Resource</u> <u>Center</u> or a <u>Community Mental Health Center</u>.

## **Qualifications:**

- Have an intellectual or developmental disability.
- Meet the requirements for residences in an intermediate care facility for individuals with an intellectual disability.
- Meet the financial qualifications for Medicaid.
